- 2.3 Analysis of data to select the final root cause(s) (Statistical data analysis)
- 2.4 Effectiveness of tools used throughout the project

3. Project Solutions (40 marks)

- 3.1 Problem solving tools/methods used, innovative ideas, best practices considered, technologies leveraged/adopted/used to develop possible solutions
- 3.2 Final selection of solution(s) (Statistical interpretations)
- 3.3 Innovativeness/value-added or value creation clarity from the final solution
- 3.4 Stakeholder (SH) engagement/Co- creation
- 3.5 Implementation plan & Implementation

4. Results (60 marks)

- 4.1 Results achieved/productivity improved
- 4.2 Impact of results to the organization's goals/objectives/vision
- 4.3 Tangible benefits achieved and reported
- 4.4 Intangible benefits achieved and reported
- 4.5 Sustainability of solution explained
- 4.6 Creation of spin-offs for other opportunities and/or continual improvement efforts
